FAST FACTS

ADULT HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA / SPECTRUM

- 6 sections offered (3 am & 3 pm)
- 3 teachers, 1 counselor
- 153 students served
- 59 Adult Diploma graduates
- 13 transfers from Wilson High School graduated through Adult High School Diploma
- 54 students took ELA exit exam (55% pass rate)
- 64 students took Math exit exam (41% pass rate)
- 50% Santa Clara residents
- 20 students enrolled directly from WHS, SCHS, NVHS or Wilson
- 5 IEP students enrolled from the district high schools – 3 of which were grads in 2011
- 3 CalWorks (Welfare to Work) students
- Funding from federal Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Grant and state apportionment
- One-Hundred and Thirty WIA objectives achieved by students, funding for each objective will be received in 2012-13 school year.

GED & ADULT BASIC SKILLS

- 2 classes offered (am & pm)
- 2 teachers, 1/2 clerical support
- 358 student registrations processed
- 239 am registrations, 65 pm registrations
- 62% district residents
- 40% of students are Homeless Adults,
- 10% CalWorks
- 51 students earned GED in 2010-11
- ('08/'09 = 32, '09/'10 = 43)
- 347 GED sub tests taken
- 88% passed with scores of 410 or higher

- Funding from Workforce Investment Act Grant and state apportionment
- Ninety-Two WIA objectives achieved by students, funding for each objective will be received in 2012-13 school year.

PARTNERSHIPS

- Program partners with [Santa Clara University Arrupe Project](#). Ten-Twelve university students work on-on-one in our classrooms each term.
- Program also partners with the [HOBA Volunteer Project \(Hands on Bay Area\)](#). The project sends valley professionals to work with our students once a month.
- [Mission City Fund](#), a Santa Clara community fund, provided \$1200 to the program to offset the cost of GED testing for low income Santa Clara City residents.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Math Preparation class offered for the high school exit exam. The class was geared for those students who were having trouble passing the Math exit exam. Nine students passed the exam as a direct result of taking the Math class.

RESULTS

- 51 students received GED
- 59 students completed high School diploma
- Two-hundred and twenty-two WIA objectives achieved by students, funding for each objective will be received in 2012-13.
