HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY

High School Equivalency

What is a High School Equivalency (HSE)? In California, adults who left high school before graduation have another way to secure a high school equivalency credential. There are two HSE exams, the HiSET and the GED.

What does a HSE credential mean for me?

It means that, through testing, you can demonstrate you have the same skills and knowledge as a high school graduate.
Once you pass the test, the California Department of Education will issue you a high school equivalency certificate.

We offer free classes to prepare you to pass one of the two exams, the HiSET and the GED.


